ABOUT NEHU, SHILLONG

North-Eastern Hill University was set up by an Act of Parliament and notified on 19th July 1973. The objectives of the University, as laid down in the act, are "to disseminate and advance knowledge by providing instructional and research facilities in such branches of learning as it may deem fit; to pay special attention to the improvement of the social and economic conditions and welfare of the people of the hill areas of the North-eastern region, and in particular, the intellectual, academic and cultural advancement."

Popularly known as NEHU, the university stands tall in the northern part of Shillong in its green, lush picturesque and homely atmosphere. Being the oldest Central University in the region, NEHU caters to students and scholars from all parts of the north-eastern region as well as also from other parts of the country and abroad.

ABOUT ZOOLOGICAL SOCIETY, KOLKATTA

The Zoological Society, Kolkata was established on December 11, 1945. The object of the Society was "to form an association of workers in the field of Zoology for furtherance of the cause of Zoology and Zoologists." Apart from publishing The proceedings in collaboration with Springer India Pvt. Ltd. (since 1948) the Society organizes several awards and competitions to encourage Young minds. Since 1961 The Society is awarding Fellowships (honoris causa) as a mark of recognition to celebrated Zoologists who can use F.Z.S. (Cal.) after their names. The society also organizes several training and capacity building programs for Students, Research Scholars and Faculties of various Institutions. Last year the society had organized The National Level Young Scientists' Meet (YSM II).

HOW TO REACH SHILLONG

Shillong is 125 km away from Guwahati Airport and 100 km from Guwahati Railway station. After reaching Guwahati airport/railway station, one may hire a taxi/deluxe bus/Tata sumo to reach Shillong town and can then take a local taxi to reach NEHU campus. While hiring a reserved taxi from Guwahati, one should come directly to NEHU campus, Umshing-Mawkynroh, Shillong -793022.

Title and Author(s) name(s) should be in bold letters, font size-12, with presenter's name underlined and with full address with E-mail ID. No diagrams, figures, tables and references are to be added in the abstract. Abstracts should be sent via e-mail (ramanujamsunkam@gmail.com & akynehu@hotmail.com) and the hard copy should be sent by post along with the Registration form and Accommodation form to the Organising Secretary.
